

*Note: during the Challenge (not including MLFTU) expired gear will be acceptable.

History to the forefront:

Does your fire department have any historical pieces that you would be proud to display during the Challenge? Please reach out, we would love to share the history of our fire community.

Saturday Challenges

Challenge One – Search & Rescue

- This will be a scenario set up in a mock apartment. Your team will have to search and ensure all victims are found based on your departments operating procedures and safely removed from the structure.
- A maximum of 15mins is given to each team to complete the challenge.

Challenge Two – Nance Drill

- Working as a Rapid Intervention Crew
- Demonstrate the ability to package and raise a firefighter, from a below grade setting with the use of tools provided
- A maximum of 15mins is given to each team to complete the challenge.

Challenge Three – Package Drill

- Follow a hose through multiple obstacles to find downed firefighter, package and rescue back through all obstacles
- A maximum of 15mins is given to each team to complete the challenge.

Challenge Four – Denver Style Drill

- Find and rescue through a window
- Perform a rescue of a downed/disorientated or lost firefighter, utilizing the "Denver" style techniques.
- A maximum of 15mins is given to each team to complete the challenge.

These are training challenges that are there to test the ability of your team within the procedural guidelines of your department. Bear in mind, they may differ from other departments. Judging takes that into consideration and score accordingly.
